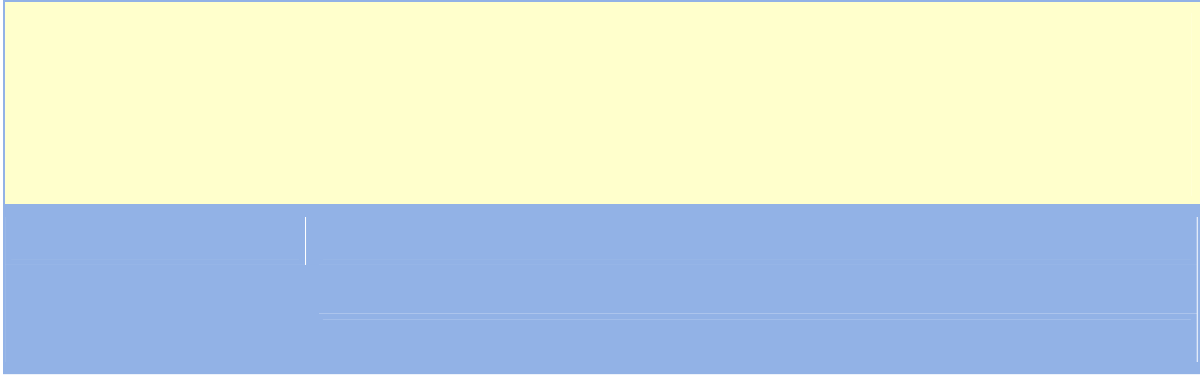

Dear Family, Friends. And Ministry Partners:

I have just recently returned from India where I had the privilege of teaching 22 students and pastors Soteriology. We had a great time and as always it is a thrill to have a small part in the lives of God's servants. I also had the blessing of making visits in the local culture with Pastor Harry. On one visit I had the opportunity to explain the meaning of Resurrection Sunday to an entire family. They paid very close attention and ask several pertinent questions. In conjunction with teaching I also was asked to preach in one of the mission churches. Pastor Suresh, a former student at the Bible institute, ministers at Open Door Baptist about 1-1/2 hour from Mangalore. I was very touched by the tenderness of the people and their attentiveness to the Word of God. The next trip will include Myanmar, India, and the Philippines and is scheduled for the first of June and will last until the first of August.

My daughter Lindsay is making good progress and has been able to take some courses at the local community college toward her nursing degree. She is still pretty scared up but seems to be dealing with it. Emma, my granddaughter is still wearing her compression suit and attends physiotherapy and counseling every week. She has a good attitude and is wide open all the time.

Linda has been marvelous through this whole experience and is Lindsay's comfort during this time of physical and emotional trial. She has been a real help-meet with me being gone.
