

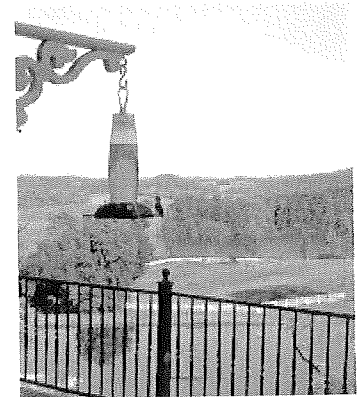

LIGHTHOUSE TO URUGUAY

One Year Anniversary

On July 2, 2009, we loaded our three kids into our minivan and launched out into full-time deputation. We headed out with great anticipation, excitement and nervousness. We had raised around 15% support on part-time deputation and had a scarce schedule of meetings. We were not sure what lay ahead, where the day-to-day finances would come from or how God would fill our schedule with meetings. We made a determination to not worry about our support, but rather to use this opportunity of deputation to challenge people to give their hearts to Christ in salvation and service. We were hopeful and believing that God would supply our finances in one year of deputation.

This past week, we reached the one year anniversary of our starting full-time deputation. As we look back, our hearts are filled with joy and gratefulness. We have had the privilege of presenting our ministry in 75 churches, we have been able to pass out hundreds of our personal tracts that we had designed and printed and we have had 40 churches and individuals who have chosen to partner with our ministry. We were also blessed with our precious little Jason. God has now raised our support to 90% and opened the door for us to leave for language school in August. God blessed the first year of our missions ministry in miraculous ways.

Language School, Here We Come!

We are coming to an end of this stage of ministry called deputation. We submitted our application and have been granted preliminary approval to the Rio Grande Missionary Language School located in Edinburg, TX. The classes for the school start on **August 9**.



After much prayer and counsel from others, we opted for the school in Texas, rather than going to Uruguay or Costa Rica. Our initial plan was to head straight to Uruguay to learn the language, but after talking with others, we realized that expecting Erika to learn the language as well as watch over the household and adjust to the culture would be much too difficult. We believe that this option will create the best environment for us and our children to learn the language.

Once we decided that a language school was the best option for us, it was a matter of choosing where. The best two options that we heard of were Costa Rica and Edinburg, TX. When thinking through the logistics of shipping for a family of six, it made much more sense to us to stay in the States rather than

shipping our stuff to Costa Rica then to Uruguay. Another factor is that the school in Texas takes only ten months to complete versus the twelve months in Costa Rica, which means that we will be able to arrive in Uruguay two months sooner.

The Rio Grande Language School consists of four hours a day of class study, one hour of time with a private tutor as well as nightly homework. The three younger boys will be going to the daycare hosted by the Language School and Jeshua will be attending a local Independent Baptist School. **We are excited!**



Creation Museum in Kentucky

God has raised our **support to 80%** over the last couple of months and we are trusting him to bring in the last 20% before August. We need approximately **twelve new supporting churches** over these last three months to reach our budgeted goals. We are excited to see how God is going to supply our needs.

We have done a lot of traveling since April. We drove up to Niagara Falls, through Canada to Michigan, down through Ohio to West Virginia over to the Creation Museum in Kentucky, back to West Virginia and then back to Virginia all in two weeks. It was a profitable trip as well as enjoyable.

The deputation ministry is fun. On top of all the traveling, we get to tell people about Jesus and encourage saints to give of their lives to evangelize the world.
