We are constantly adjusting and modifying our different programs within the church, Bible institute, and Christian school to better serve our people. I have to say, even though there seems to be a lot of additional work, there are also a lot of new blessings that have followed these difficult times. Our many Zoom meetings have had great and growing attendance. Also, our Sunday Morning Service is doing well. God has blessed us with 8 new families this year. We are grateful for all He is doing for New Life Baptist Church.

Planning the Christmas activities this year was a new ballgame. Our ladies Christmas Banquet was limited this year to only members of the church. There was also only one cook for the meal this year, even though the menu was extensive: turkey, ham, bacon and sausage pasta, potato salad, shrimp salad, mixed vegetables, Hawaiian rolls, chocolate cake and vanilla ice cream. I thought I would never finish, but I had great joy in preparing this special meal for our ladies.

Our National Pastor's Christmas was a tremendous success this year. God touched a few individuals and churches to help with our Pastors' needs that went beyond that of previous years. Each pastor received enough food and offering to sustain their families for about 6 weeks. God sent a blessing that overflowed to us all! We are preparing to assist them again in February and March, as many are facing great needs for food, medications, and bills. One expense that all our Pastors have faced is internet charges to conduct church services from their home. Many of our Pastors had no need for internet at their homes before Covid-19. We are happy to report that not only have none of the Dominican churches had to close during these difficult days, but God has helped us to start two new ones during 2020! It is my pleasure once again to share with our co-laborers all the happening in the Dominican Republic.

First, I would like to share with you about the great Soul Winning Conferences we had in Santo Domingo and Constanza. In order to be better equipped to reach others for Christ, we brought the national leaders together for soul winning training. The classes lasted for three days in each location and many of our church leaders were able to attend the training sessions. Pray that God will continue to bless our efforts as we prepare people to win the lost at all cost. May we see the value of each soul through the eyes of Christ! This is our primary goal as we do God's work in this country!









Also, we were privileged to help families at a Children's Hospital by bringing personal items that they need on a daily basis and to share the gospel with parents who were there with young children. We thank God for the opportunity to share His message while encouraging these families during a difficult time. Please pray for them as they face many difficulties while trying to care for a sick child. Pray that we will be able to continue this ministry of sharing His Word and being a small help in meeting the needs of these families.

Mission Update:

We have had leaks in the roof at New Life Baptist Church for the past 4 years. In the beginning they were small, but as time went on, leaks after the hurricane season became bigger and harder to patch. Due to Covid-19 and all the travel measures being taken by the government of the Dominican Republic, were unable to get a group to come for a roof replacement until recently. We are glad to report that a team from IBBI came to help us reroof the church last month. The team consisted of 12 men from 4 churches in the States - Mikado Baptist in Macon, GA (our home church), Berean Baptist in Lilburn, GA, Bible Baptist in Hamilton, GA and Tabernacle Baptist in Tiger, GA.



Not only were we able to reroof the church, we were also able to paint or touch up all the classrooms for the coming year. In addition, we replaced all the sound system cables and put in a new Wi-Fi camera system. It was great to see our Nationals quickly joining in to work with the group the Lord brought together to address these great needs of New Life Baptist Church.



Hebrews 13:21 says, "Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen." We thank God for all opportunities to be pleasing in His sight and give him glory. I believe the Spirit was very strongly in our midst the entire week. In January we visited the boy's orphanage in Santo Domingo and were able to take food and a gift for each of the boys! What blessing it was to teach God's Word, and to sing and play games with them, but most of all, to see their faces and know that we brought joy and hope for a better tomorrow. What a privilege it is to be used by God to encourage another person that He loves them and has not forgotten them.





The remainder of January was spent with emphasis on reaching others for Christ. Each Sunday we challenged our people to bring visitors to services. It was a blessing to see our members bringing others each week to church. We welcomed 43 visitors during the four Sunday challenge! Dear Co-laborers,

There have been many great victories during 2020 which I am grateful to have been part of. After returning to the D.R. in July, I faced a mountain that seemed impossible to climb. I begin by asking God to remove the mountain and during the following 8 weeks, He provided everything we needed to eliminate each obstacle that arose during the previous 5 months of COVID-19. These obstacles included food for our National Pastors, many medical needs, aid to suffering church members, many ministry bills that had to be paid, and a balloon payment on the church property. God in His graciousness supplied all the needs. Praise the Lord!

As each one of these needs was resolved, God continued to remind me of Job. The things that He allows, He can also remove at any time He so desires. This has been my life story over the past 38 years of serving God! I have to say, the faith needed in 2020 has surpassed the faith needed in previous years.

On August 31, I was praying regarding the great challenge I faced the following day with some difficult decisions and meetings. I asked God to give a special blessing for one of those meetings, which would occur at 2:00 p.m. I prayed the same again the following morning. At 10:00 a.m., while sitting at my desk, Denny (Office Manager) informed me there was a man on the phone who insisted on meeting with me that day. She told him that was not possible because I had no opening available. However, the Lord was leading me to TAKE TIME, so I agreed to meet with him. Twelve years before this man had been married to one of our church members and had visited our church several times. During that time we had prayed for him on numerous occasions. When he arrived at my office, I asked if there was a problem with one of our students that I saw him drop off several times last year. That was not the problem. He explained that when he visited the church many years ago, he felt that if he ever needed help, I would help him. When I asked what was the problem, He answered that for many years he have known an emptiness inside that nothing seemed to satisfy. He said, "I have all a man could want, but no fulfillment. Do you have the answer to this emptiness in my heart?" I was thrilled to tell Lorenzo that I indeed had the key to unlock the emptiness and bring fulfillment in his life. One and a half hours later, he asked Jesus to come into his heart! I shared verses of assurance with him and he asked if I had time to teach him the Bible. I explained that we have a discipleship program and that I would meet with him once a week. He asked if we could meet twice a week instead! We are meeting twice a week, he is growing,


and though I received a different blessing than what I asked for, it was the best blessing that God could give. It is a great feeling when someone looks for you to tell them about Jesus.

April-May 2020

Dear Friends,

We are thanking God for all His blessings during these difficult times. Chona and I have been Christians for 40 years and have faced many trials during those years. Some I thought we might not survive, but with each one came new found strength from the Lord. With each major trial we gained better understanding of our Lord and His desires for our lives. I would say that our current trial has reached beyond all others combined, but our previous hardships have taught us to be more calm and patient as we face the current world situation.

I was in the U.S. speaking at a Missions Conference when I received the news that the Dominican was closing airports and I would not be able to return. This was genuinely concerning since Chona was still in the D.R. One of our Dominican pastors informed me that hospitals were sending people home who had COVID-19 because they were overwhelmed and unable to handle any more patients. Since Chona was considered a high risk because of her medical condition, she needed to get out of the D.R. as well as our son Jonathan and his family. We thank God for clearing the way for them to return safely to the U.S.

Everything in the Dominican was shut down except for essential personnel. The country was placed under martial law with a 5:00 p.m. curfew. Our ministries were immediately faced with many great challenges. Our church, the national pastors and their ministries, and the Christian school were all met with new requirements as students had to continue classes via the internet. God supplied the answer quickly for these challenges through WhatsApp and Zoom. Not only are we continuing all of our regular activities at New Life Baptist Church, but we have also added 2 additional Bible studies on Tuesday and Friday night to keep our people involved. We even have 3 new families in the area who are participating in 2 services weekly. We are extremely excited about all God is doing.





Many of our pastors are in distress due to the shutdown in the Dominican. Their needs are great and the calls were many, exceeding what we could conceive, but we serve a great God who is always in control. We simply prayed and laid the matter before our Lord. We followed His words in Matthew 7:7, "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." We shared the need and God is answering. We are grateful to Him and those He is using to meet the need. Please pray with us in this matter. We appreciate your prayers and support.




their hands acknowledging they had made a decision. We thank God for all He is doing and for allowing us to have a part.


May-June 2018

Almost 2 years ago, Pastor Melido approached me with a plan to start a new church deep in the mountains of Constanza, in a village called Convent. This village of 950 people is a farming community. I told Melido that we were in a difficult time financially due to the Santo Domingo Project at New Life Baptist Church, but as God provided I would help him with this new church. Being very careful with expenses, we were able to start the work at a cost of \$150 per month. Melido would be responsible for \$50.00 of this expense and my part would be the remaining \$100. I didn't have this monthly amount, but believed God would provide. During the last 21 months, I have made a total of 8 trips to this new work. On one such trip, the Catholic priest heard we were coming and used his sound system to disrupt the service. Pastor Melido continued to press forward with the work and in March of this year, a farmer in the church donated a small piece of land for a building. We made plans to construct a building for Iglesia Buatista Ebenezer in June-July of this year.



Recently my son Jonathan had a group from the States coming to construct a building for a church in a one of the sugar cane villages of La Romana. Permission fell through to build, yet the group would be arriving in only a few





able to get the materials needed to complete the building in Convent. I am always overwhelmed by how God can change things so quickly and bring Christians to work

together in unity to accomplish His divine purpose. When all was done, this project which was supposed to cost \$15,000 was completed for less than \$10,000. Before leaving, Pastor Lance preached a service in the new church. Including the church members and the work group from Byron, Georgia, there were about 85 people





in attendance. When I gave the invitation, 28 people raised their hands to accept Christ as Savior. We are so thankful to God for allowing us to have a part in what He is doing here.

because they bathe outdoors and their bathroom is an outhouse behind the house. We are grateful the Lord has given us an opportunity to help these people.





With this loan, the church will save over \$125,000 in interest during the course of the loan. We are asking the Lord to help us make a \$150,000 deposit in the first months of 2017.

- Resurrection Baptist Seminary began the spring semester with 87 students.
- Twelve people have been saved and 8 baptized for the glory of God!
- New Life Baptist Church celebrated its 13th anniversary on February 2 with a record attendance of 245! We put out additional chairs almost every service with our men standing in the back many Sundays.
- A new plan for Sunday School is working well and has increased our attendance.
- New focus in our teen outreach has boosted involvement and attendance.
- Two new churches have been started and plans are underway for 3 more church plants next year.

To compensate for this new growth, over the next few months we will be increasing our staff to 2 Dominican nationals and 4 American missionaries to support both the church and school ministries. We are also finalizing plans for the purchase of property to accommodate our growing ministries. We anticipate moving to the new property on August 1. Our floor and yard space will increase by 40% or more at the new location.




