Dear brother in Christ,

We greet you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, whose return we are waiting more than ever! In this way, we would like to thank you and to show you how grateful we are, that you were always beside us in our ministry and through hard times. Through you, God has done, over time, a lot of miracles for us and He fulfilled, in this way, His promise that He will always provide.

We would like to say thank you to all our brothers and sisters in Christ, who backed us up in this spiritual war, and supported us with prayers and with financial needs!

It was a very hard year for us, just in the last month I have lost my mother and my 62 years old sister, both being infected with covid19. But even in this darkness and for many-hopeless times, we can see the Light guiding and encouraging us, and Jesus remains our only Hope.

He is still fulfilling us with gratefulness and even when everything seems so hard and confusing, we can say loudly and clearly: Ebenezer, thus far the Lord has helped us!

We have seen, in these times of despair, that even after so many years, the Gospel is still the best news a man can receive, that there is no other salvation, there is no other hope for one man's soul, than God's pure love poured in His Gospel. His Gospel, His Word is the only thing that can bring peace and erase the fear, the despair and the confusion of the people. The people need God more than ever, and we pray to God to renew our strength and give us power to serve Him further according to His will.

We have not been vaccinated and we intend to remain this way. There are a lot of restrictions now in Romania and everything is very tight, but the vaccine is not a legal obligation yet and we do not fear something that may harm our earthly body. We are trying though to take care of our elderly from the church and to protect them not just from this virus but also from this fear and panic that filled the world, by encouraging and guiding them to the Word.

Another update from us, is that we have recently changed our van with a minivan Seat Alhambra with 7 seats. The reason is that we had to pay an annual tax of 250\$ for the van and also the fuel consumption was high. With the recent rise of gas prices we have observed this is no longer affordable for us. For the mini-van, the tax is only 60\$ per year, and also the gas consumption is considerably lower, but because the car is from 2005, we had to pay for the maintenance and for the replacement of some parts, in order to pass the annual check.

We remained with a debt of 1000\$ because of these costs but we learned to trust God that He will provide in time, like always.

We find that sometimes, especially when all things seem impossible and all the doors seem closed, it is very hard to depend only on Him from day to day, that He will provide. And as human beings, we have failed many times to fully trust Him. But God showed us that He knows our needs better than us, and provides us not only with physical nourishment, but also with spiritual nourishment just in time.

In this note, we would also like to encourage you to put all your trust in God, our lovely Father who will always take care of His children and who always nourishes us spiritually, physically and emotionally.

We wish you peace and health and may the grace of God be upon your families and your church!

The more we are tried in different ways the more we wait for our Lord to come back.

There's not many news regarding our ministry, the brothers and sisters are very old and often ill and the kids have all left home. Our daughter Andreea got married and they left for studies in Germany. Tony is working in Timisoara and Estera finished with university and is now working with a christian organization called M.I.A (Mission in action).

Coco has also finished college and is looking for work.

Because he graduated he is no longer considered a minor and we were asked to adopt another kid but because our house is still in construction we didn't fill in the requirements and our request was denied. So my wife is out of job - Radu is still with us, but we lost the pay.

We are thinking of working with orfans in the future but with a christian organization instead of the government, if we manage to finish the construction. Recently we visited my mother who is now a widow after my father passed away. Please pray for us.

I thank God all the time for your ministry and your prayers. For all these years I have been encouraged by your spiritual and financial support and I pray and hope that I will never disappoint you.

The older we grow, we find more and more things to worry and complain about. The rest of the brothers who stayed in the church building in Berini are willing to unite with us again but we did not agree to go back to Males's building.

He and his men are baptizing people that were not born again, and don't have a changed life and we are upset of their testimony.

I'm wondering and praying more often about His will for me in this village because I'm growing older working and suffering and I see very few results.

It's harder for me and the church without the kids, since I can't bring them home in the weekend anymore. The car is eating now over 10% and something is broken more and more often. We need to change the oil and the filters, the timing belt (I have over 70k km now) and the break plates.


A smaller, less gas consuming car would be useful, be it 10 years older and I could use the minibus when we need space.

I started breaking the walls in our bathroom and found the water pipes broken in 3 places. I fixed the pipes and now we have water in our bathroom again.

My dear brothers, please pray for us that we manage to buy fire wood. I trust His faithfulness that He will find a solution for us this winter.

Marcel finished his licence and is looking for work, our girls are also working/looking for part-time work to help with their college fees. Our church sends many blessing in Him and our unchanging message: Rom 14:8


The warm water pipes and the boiler in the bathroom cracked because of the cold but we thank God that we are well.
