Greetings! Our primary focus is always the spiritual growth of the people of Morrisseau. To date, the church has maintained a steady attendance. The presence of our three pastors from Open Door Baptist Church provided the much needed spiritual awakening that we longed for. All three pastors had a powerful impact on our mission. Pastor Stewart gave an inspiring teaching from the book of Genesis, Pastor Farley taught Christology and Pastor Farhenger's evangelization took place in the outdoor market (marche) in Morrisseau. Over 400 tracks were distributed to the people along the route. Although no one publicly accepted Christ at the time, Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." We know for certain that the seeds of faith were planted by the work of all three pastors. We continue to work earnestly with the people to make sure that their hearts are prepared to hear the Word of God, so that they can be receptive to the work of our pastors. The participants were very happy and were eager for them to return. We look forward to seeing the fruits of their ministry, in the future.

### Construction Updates

We are happy to report that L' Eglise Baptiste de Morisseau and the Good Samaritan School of Morisseau now has windows and doors. Additionally, a walkway from the front of the school to the back of the school, has been constructed for the students. This is important because when it rained, the water would accumulate in the back of the school and enter the building. The overflow of water would either displace the students or at times cause the school to close. Furthermore, the construction of a bathroom for the school has begun. While the bathroom is not fully functional, the students are grateful.

## GOOD SAMARITAN SCHOOL OF MORISSEAU

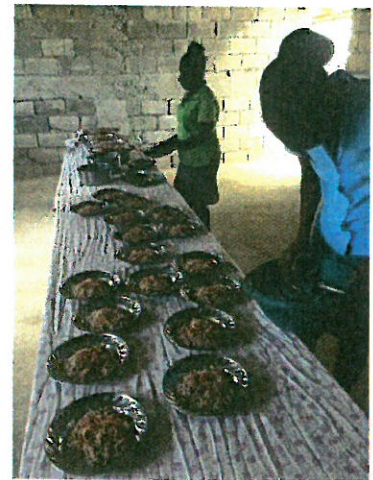
### Making the Grade
