We also plan to add a baptistery, fellowship area and kitchen. There is a water shortage in that part of town, and we ask that you pray for a solution to this issue. We may need to dig a well if all else fails.

Our weekly church wide soul-winning time is going well with new people coming out. Since our last letter in January, over 80 people have trusted Christ.

We are still receving the occasional Christmas card and anniversary card, such is the postal service here. Once again we appreciate the well wishes; thank you for thinking of us. With the travel bans still in place, we cannot even begin to think about, let alone plan, our next trip to the States. Thankfully we were able to get a full refund on two of our tickets. We look forward to someday being able to travel again and getting to visit some of you and hopefully be a blessing to your church.

We truly are thankful for your faithfulness in supporting us financially and in prayer. These are trying times indeed, but one thing is certain: God is on the throne and Jesus is returning any day now. Let's keep looking up as we work the white fields of His harvest.

Greetings from the wet and sultry northeastern Brazil winter. We did not get much of a summer as it has remained quite rainy since last winter. This has caused some impact on our ministry.

Our soul winning stats remain way down as in our last update. Since then we can report 72 souls having trusted Christ. We have had to cancel several churchwide soulwinning times. I really don't like having to do this as it not only means the Gospel gets out less but also our people get out less. There is no better exercise to keep the Christian in spiritual shape than sharing the Gospel.

We even had to cancel a midweek service due to the weather. That particular Wednesday the rain was quite brutal, causing floods and landslides. Several roads including main throughfares were blocked, leading to mayhem that afternoon and evening. Many families lost their homes due to landslides, some their lives. Others lost many possessions to water damage. We have had it relatively mild; Pernambuco, a state a few hours north of us, had major flooding and hundreds perished.

It is so good to see the difference Christ makes in people's lives. Nica is a teenage girl who has been coming to one of our churches with her grandmother Josilene, who raises her. Nica told us how thankful she is that Josilene has become "a different person" since coming to church. On a different occasion Josilene said just as much about Nica.

Please pray the Lord continues to bless both churches. Thank you for your faithful prayers and financial support.



This year has both shaken and stirred churches everywhere, in more ways than one. For better or for worse, 2020 has been a game-changer and an eye-opener. I do not know about anyone else, but I am certainly looking up more than ever, not only because Heaven seems sweeter every day, but also because the current climate tells me gathering time is getting closer.

We have recommenced in-person services for both churches, albeit with a few changes in place. Still we gather, we sing, I preach, we fellowship, and church happens. Some of our people are still genuinely apprehensive and not ready to return to normal. Others, sadly, seem to be taking "time off."

However most of our folks are ready for normalcy and realize how vital church is. We have been limiting our crowd, and it has broken our hearts to have to turn visitors away. Last week, the person responsible for "vetting" people at the front door left his post, and before we knew it, we had eight visitors "sneak" in. We have since scrapped that rule!

Our church-wide soul winning time is back also, although we are not going out in pairs as is our custom. It has been fantastic! People are primed and ready! They want to listen! There are fewer of us going, but we continue to get the Gospel out. I tell our folks we need to make up for lost time. Since our last update, over 50 people have trusted Christ.

By this time, Simone and I should have already been on and returned from our short furlough. We are still waiting on travel bans to be lifted to plan ahead. It actually worked out for the best that we were not able to go. Had we not been here during these exceptional times, things could have been very different.

Thank you for you faithfulness in prayer and financial support during these trying times. Let us all remain faithful while we wait for Him.

Since our last letter it seems the world has taken many turns and gone through much change, not necessarily for the better. However, one thing remains the same: God loves sinners and Christ died to save every single one.

Like everyone else, we too have had to adapt to these unprecedented times. From having to cut short a visit to Salvador in Bahia (a 20 hour round-trip drive) and leave town a few hours after arriving because the governor decreed a full lockdown, to having to reschedule our flights to the States, not once or twice but three times, due to cancelations and finally the travel ban.

So no, we did not make our planned furlough. We believe we now know why the Lord closed that door. We have been very busy helping many people from both our churches, and others, to remain healthy and fed during this time. The state government we are in has done a terrible job; not only are they not helping, but they have also gone out of their way to make life more difficult. We have been involved in providing food for many people who lost their livelihoods and are in need.

Unfortunately, we have had two fatalities in our circle. Both were due not to the virus but rather the lack of treatment, even though they were hospitalized. As I write this letter, we have a dear member, André, who is currently in the hospital. If you saw our video preparing the land for the new church, he was the guy cutting the trees down. Please pray for André to fully remover.

We praise the Lord for the arrival of Claire Emilia Higley, Christian and Gabriela's first child and our first granddaughter. We do miss terribly not being able to be there as planned, but mother and baby are doing fine and we thank the Lord for that.

In the midst of all the turmoil, people's attention have turned to life and death and beyond; but the fear that has been sown is great, and most people are fearful and opportunities are scarce. We have seen precious few people trust Christ, maybe a dozen or so, since our last report.

We appreciate your prayers and your faithful support for the work here in Maceió. Pray the Lord gives wisdom to navigate these changing tides we are all facing.

We plan to add a few classrooms for now and, as finances permit, a larger space for the adults.

On the family front, both grandsons Liam and Kaleb continue to grow and be a never-ending source of joy. It was a blessing to have Christian and Gabriela visit us recently; they were able to fly down for a week in August to meet Kaleb.

There is much news that we wish to bring you up to speed on with the letter.

On the family front, our second grandson Kaleb has arrived, and both mom and baby are doing well. Liam is growing up fast and we now have two little ones on whom to bestow doting frenzy.

You may find it hard to believe, but we are still receiving Christmas cards! Such is the postal system here. Once again we appreciate every card, note and gift we receive. Thank you for thinking of us.

We covet your prayers for our Missions Emphasis in May. We will be having Bro. Guaraci, one of our missionaries, visit with his family to report and challenge us to do more for missions. Bro. Guaraci is a national pastor working in Sergipe, the state south of us. Theirs is the only independent Baptist church in that state. Please also pray for our mission's conference in October.

The new church plant is growing. I am personally very encouraged with the work there. In fact, we had plans to expand the facility by adding an auditorium and classrooms. Notice that I said we "had" plans. Why is that? Well, we recently discovered there is a possibility that the whole community will be moved and the area bulldozed to make way for a new road system. That doesn't sound too encouraging, does it? Thankfully, there is a silver lining to this situation. In such cases as this, the people are relocated and given—yes, given homes in new government housing developments. Typically, government housing is larger and has better infrastructure than where we are now. So if indeed such plans go ahead, the church would get a new building and move along with the people of that neighborhood, to a part of the city with even more people to reach. The one drawback is that until we know for certain what the future holds, we have to put any building expansion plans on hold. Until then we continue to become increasingly crowded, especially the children's ministry.

Simone and I have to make an unplanned trip to the US to address pressing bank issues which require our physical precense. From June 6th to July 8th, we will be stateside in the Connecticut, Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio areas. Pray we can accomplish all that is necessary.

Since our last update we have had 260+ people profess faith in Christ. Thank you for your part in this ministry. Remember us in prayer.

It has almost been a month since I returned from a 10 day visit to the States. It was great to spend time with Christian and Gabby who were wonderful hosts to me. Gabby accompanied me in all but one trip so we had time to catch up. The only downside was that I traveled alone since Simone stayed in Maceio. It was however wonderful to visit friends I had not seen in a long time. It is quite amazing the bond with which the Holy Spirit binds the brethren. It was a shame to leave so soon after arriving, but we will have eternity in Heaven to fellowship. At the moment, we still have work to be done here, much work.

Speaking of work, Shadow of the Almighty Baptist Church will hold its first official service on Sunday, October 7. The promotional literature is back from the printers. We have started canvassing and my main worry now is that we will not have enough room to accommodate the large numbers of people who say they are coming. We may have to contact people and have two inaugural services (how weird is that?) We may need to start building a larger auditorium on the property sooner than we thought. Please pray for the Lord to send the people and supply the needs as we strive and labour to move forward.

While canvassing the area around the new church, we witnessed what I can only describe as a miracle. A five-year-old boy who lives in that community was walking home with his mother and siblings when he was struck by a passing car. After fully hitting and throwing the little boy, the car also ran over him. I heard the screech, the thud and the screams and cries, but I hesitated to look envisaging the carnage and turmoil. The boy stood up and ran to the curb where his mom picked him up. When I approached to check on the situation to pass along information to the medic in the ambulance I had called, he was alive, in one piece and sobbing. I attempted to calm the mother as I told her an ambulance was on its way. It was heartbreaking to see his siblings run home in tear and despair. I will call in on them to see how they are doing. It definitely was a miracle. Now we need to go tell them of an even greater miracle.

Since our letter in July, 160+ souls have trusted Christ. Thank you for caring for souls and lives in Maceió. Remember us in prayer.

Dear praying friends,

For a while now we have been planning on slowing down a little, to catch our breath, so to speak. Well, we are still looking forward to that. With the new church and the associated building project, we have been caught up in a whirlwind of busyness. I'm excited to share the following updates.

We can now envisage a starting date for the first service of the Shadow of the Almighty Baptist Church. Believe me, the name sounds a lot better in Portuguese; even more so because the new church is located in a place known to the locals as "the shadow." The folks nearby are enthusiastic and delighted at the new church. They have watched us work and have seen how much is being invested to create a place for the church to meet that is as first-class as we can make it.

We have met with several hiccups along the way, but the Lord has supplied every need. A new roof had to go up, and there were water-pipe leakages and then later water shortages to be dealt with; the list goes on. Another thing that created a huge overhead in terms of time and expense was the incredible amount of red tape we had to go through. Unfortunately this is very common in Brazil.

Speaking of hiccups, a few weeks ago a runaway horse-trailer became unhitched from a truck right in front of our church. It came careening down the street and into our parked car, narrowly missing two passing girls. The trailer crashed into the very spot where I had been standing a few moments earlier. Thank you to whoever was praying for us at the time: nobody was injured. Our car did not fare so well, but the damage was mainly cosmetic. Auto insurance around here is not required and for the guilty party to pay for repairs is not the usual outcome. Indeed, the truck driver did not have insurance, but he did pay out of pocket to fix our vehicle. That, in and of itself, is another miracle. So thank you again for praying.

We have not yet set an actual date for the inaugural service, but it will most likely be within the next six weeks or so. You only get to start a church once, and so we try to get it right that one time. We are waiting on the flyers from the printers, the final touches and clean up on the property, a pulpit, tables and chairs, and one other thing - which brings us to the next item at hand.

On August 3rd, I will be travelling to the United States for ten days. Simone will stay behind as it is such a short trip. I will be staying in Connecticut with our daughter Gabriela and son-in-law Christian. I have scheduled six meetings in churches within a two hour driving distance from their home. One of the reasons for the trip is to pick up some personal supplies and ministry supplies for both churches.

Soon after my return on August 13th, a definite start date will be set for within the month. If all goes according to plan, by the next update we should have news about the new church starting in earnest.

Thank you to all the churches that have contributed financially with the new church plant. Let me just say that our "old" church here, Metropolitan Baptist Church, has matched every penny given.

Since our previous update, 445+ souls have professed faith in Christ. Thank you for being steadfast in prayer and financial support. Together much is being accomplished for the cause of Christ. Remember us in prayer.

The big 2017 push is well under way. As we mentioned in our last update, we had chosen a location and a building for the new church plant. The Lord blessed tremendously and provided the full amount. However when the time came for us to close on the property, it had already been sold. As always, when the Lord closes a door he opens another. Not long after that became unavailable to us, a better opportunity presented itself. Having the funds in hand, I am thrilled to report that we purchased a piece of land with a good sized building on it. It did not come without its share of drama and haggling; and although I would like to say it was my extreme bargaining and negotiating skills that saw us through, it was God Who steered everything His way. The new site is in a great location and has a better layout for a church. There is one downside however: it needs a new roof, among other things. We are trying to raise an additional \$3000 to cover these unforeseen costs.

The people at the new location are excited and come by to check us out whenever we are there working, cleaning and fixing things. We cannot as yet set a start date because we really do need to fix the roof problem. If you can help in any way it would be a tremendous blessing and help.

This month Simone and I had the opportunity to be with missionary Juan Vallejo and his family and church. I preached for him and got to know his work in São Paulo. They too have their hands full in the Lord's work.

In other important news, we had Gomes Muanza join our church all the way from Angola; he is currently studying at the university here in Maceió. Just as importantly, we can report over 250 professions of faith from our church-wide soulwinning efforts.
