
I mention in a previous letter that we would have our second grandson in November. He was born on November 6, and his name is Harrison Jack Kelly. Now we have three grandchildren.

Then I flew to Peru from Brazil and I got to preach three different times on Sunday as you can see picture below.


Again I want to thank you for everyone of you for your prayers and love offering for my Brazil mission trip plus Peru also.



God continues to open doors for me for outreach to the deaf. Last week, I went to Kissimmee, Florida, for the Deaf Nation Expo. I had a booth to let people know about the Deaf Spiritual Leadership Camp. At the Deaf Nation Expo there were over 3,000 deaf people. Also, there was a Roman's Road of the Deaf booth to pass out tracts and witness to people, and 10 people got saved! Last Sunday, one deaf man wanted to be saved so I explained to him about Jesus Christ and he got saved. Praise the Lord!

Our church will have an Easter breakfast potluck on March 27. Pray for new people to come to hear about Jesus's Resurrection!


