Dear Pastor,

On September 19, Jerry had an operation to remove a cancerous kidney. That operation went great and he was up and taking steps the very next day. Later in the evening of September 20, something went wrong. What we didn't know yet, but Jerry had developed a serious infection called sepsis. His health deteriorated quickly and he was moved into ICU.

Over the next few days, Jerry had two more major surgeries and the doctors were optimistic that he would make a full recovery and return to missions. He was transferred to a rehab facility in Bristol, TN where they worked with him to relearn the most basic movements that we all take for granted. We knew it was going to be a long battle, but he was getting better.

This all changed in the early morning of Friday, November fourth. After a great day of physical therapy, Jerry went into cardiac arrest and he never recovered. He entered into the presence of our Lord on Saturday, November 5, 2016.

Over the last eight weeks, we have received thousands of texts, emails, and phone calls. Folk around the world have prayed for Jerry and our family. This has been a rough time for our family, but we have claimed the promises of 2 Corinthians 12:9, "And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me."

I've been in full-time ministry for my entire adult life and I do not plan to stop now. My plans are to continue to be the Office Manager at Beacon International Baptist Mission and to help continue the ministry that we started over 21 years ago. It's my heart's desire to see the world reached with the Gospel of Christ. Would you please consider continuing our support? It's vital for me to be able to continue serving our missionaries.

Jerry and I would often think and pray for our supporting churches. We always counted it a privilege to represent them on the field. We had some really sweet times visiting churches, representing the ministry. Thank you for investing in our ministry. Heaven will only tell the true impact that Jerry had on this world.

Dear Supporters and Prayer Partners,

Christine and I have been rather busy as the Season demands! Thank goodness we have been fairly close to home since Thanksgiving. December is a very demanding time for us as we have to get all the missionaries finances ready for the good ole IRS and all the 2015 files closed and 2016 opened and ready for action! We are looking for a great 2016 and are asking God for at least 5 new families to carry the Good News to the foreign lands in the New Year.

We were in New York City just before Thanksgiving and me and Missionary Adam Crabtree and Stanley Miller went to meet up with one of Adam's young preachers to hand out tracts and John-Romans. We hit the street and in one hour we had given out over 3,000 pieces of literature. It was amazing....if I could make eye contact, they would take the material and everyone was in a hurry. Occasionally I would get a smile or a "thank you" as they rushed on their way. One lady stopped and talked with Bro. Crabtree for almost an hour asking questions about the Bible and Focus Baptist Church. As I stood there in the cold night, I wondered where everyone was going and why the rush, but then I thought, "we are in New York and this is as good as it gets!" I had to pinch myself once in a while to remind me that I was not in a large foreign city, but New York City! Not much difference....all nationalities, fashions and sizes and most were on a one-way street going the wrong direction spiritually. Oh if only they would stop and think of their eternal destiny, they would slow down and take time for our Lord Jesus Christ. Only eternity will reveal what results the John-Romans distribution will bring, but we know that the Word will not return void.

When we left the City, we came home for one week and then went to Florida for a few days to see our family there. On our way home Christine got out of the truck late one evening and stepped right in the middle of a large fire ant hill. They really did a number on her and she was miserable for a few days. We counted over 100 bites on her left foot and leg and probably 75 on her right foot and leg. Those devils are a sure wicked insects and really hurt, burn and itch all at the same time. I felt sorry for her, but she survived and still has some evidence that fire ants are real and I promise she will watch where she is stepping when in the Deep South!

I just received word that our foundation in Honduras is almost finished and all is well except the name. We have tried 2 or 3 different names that the government didn't like, so I told Yery Martinez, our missionary there, to try, East Side Baptist Association and that seems to be workable. Praise the Lord! Such a small thing and so much trouble, but I think we have it now and should have the process finished very shortly. It is none too soon because Yery has bought property and is going to start his church about mid-2016. It will be a lengthy construction, but very needed and if anyone would or could help in his construction, it would be a great help to him and the ministry. Just send your gift to the mission office with "Honduras Building Project" on the check and it will go to the work immediately.

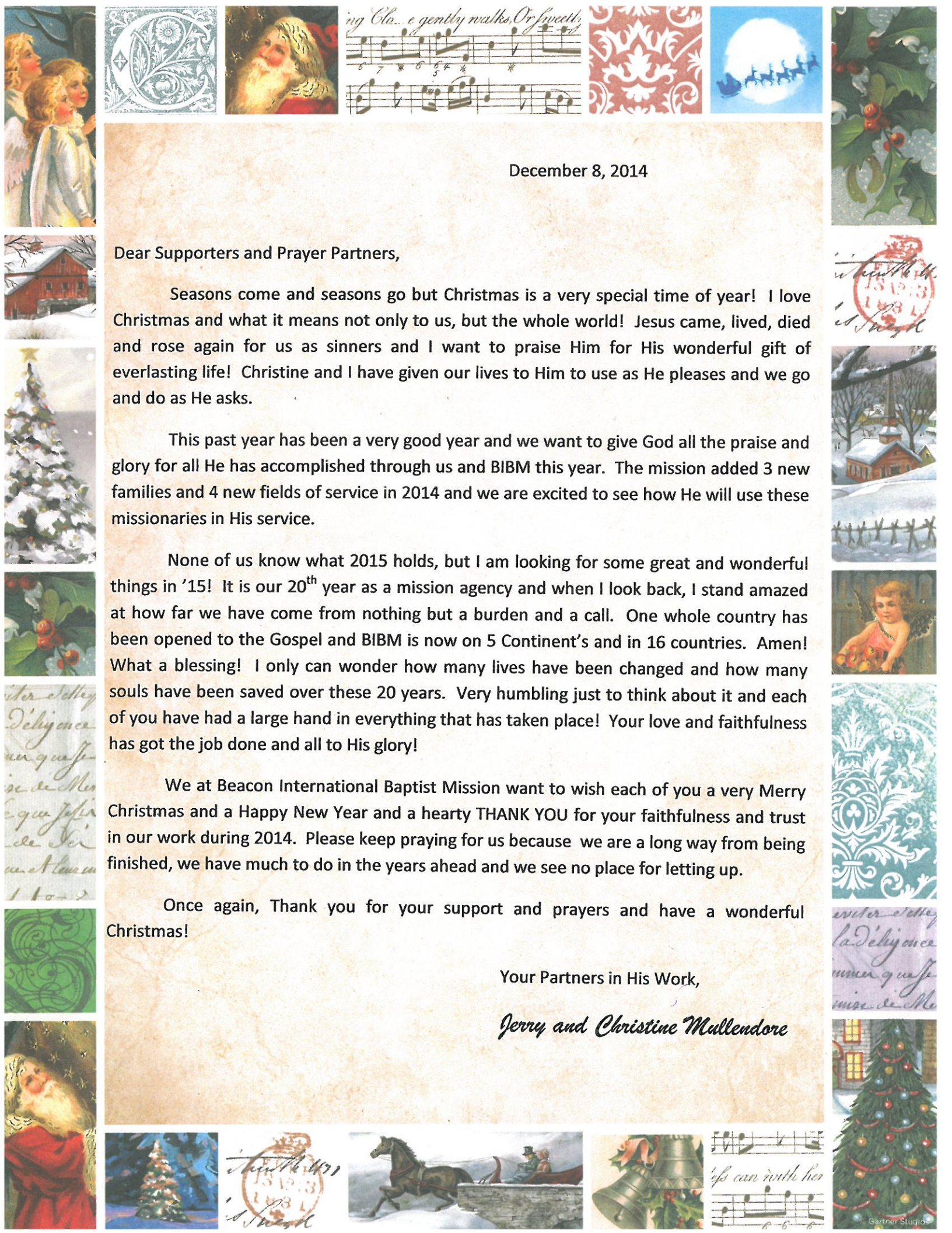

On February 26, I am heading to Honduras with 2 of our men to get a Foundation established for Yery Martinez. This Foundation, Beacon Baptist Mission of Honduras, will allow Bro. Martinez to buy property in the Foundation's name and build without a lot of hassle. It will also allow him to bring other missionaries under BBMH and solve a lot of visa problems as well as saving time. Please pray that all will go well. If anyone would like to help with the expenses of this project, it would be a great help. Total cost will be between \$1,600-\$2,000.

April is a full month. Missionary Training School is March 30 - April 3 in Spencer, Ohio. We go from Spencer, directly to a Faith Promise Conference at Calvary Baptist Church in Henderson, North Carolina for Easter Sunday through April 8. On April 21 we fly to Romania and help Bro. Keith Price in dedicating "Tina's House" which is a home for Unwed Mothers. Bro. Keith has been working on Tina's House for years and, again, if anyone would like to help in this big project, he could sure use the help and it will be an investment in lives for years to come.

We have a new family going to the Philippines to continue some work that has been on-going for over 20 years. The typhoon that came through a couple of years ago devastated Tocloban City.
